Road Maintenance Reminders

As we look forward to warmer weather, please remember,

**DO NOT BLOW GRASS
ONTO THE ROAD SURFACE!**

Grass on the roadway is a traffic hazard.
This can be a liability for the property owner.



Grass on the roadway also is a problem for road maintenance, costing us tax dollars for the extra time it takes the road crew to remove it before road grading.

Placing or storing items on the Township roads and right-of-way is not allowed. You can refer to the Ordinance on the Township website or contact the Town Office for a copy.

Remember to keep your garbage and recycling containers in your driveway off of the road, all season long. The road crew will not go around them; again it causes road maintenance issues.

2022 Election Dates to Remember

June 24 – Vote by mail or in person June 24 – August 8 for the Primary at Wright County

July 19 – Register in advance of July 19 to save time on Primary Election Day

August 9 – Primary Election Day

September 23 – Vote by mail or in person September 23 – November 7 at Wright County

October 18 – Register in advance by October 18 to save time on Election Day

November 8 – Election Day

All voters will have these races on their general election ballot:

- US Representative
- Governor & Lt. Governor
- Secretary of State
 - State Auditor
 - Attorney General
 - State Senator
- State Representative
- Judicial Seats
