

ORDINANCE # 2010.3
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING STORAGE OF ITEMS ON TOWNSHIP ROADS AND RIGHT-OF-WAY

The Town Board of Rockford Township does hereby ordain:

1. The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate parking and storage of miscellaneous materials on township roads and township right-of-way in order to expedite the maintenance and the safety of the traveling public on Township Roads.
2. No motor vehicles including passenger cars, buses, trucks, trailers, boats or other similar vehicles shall be stored on any public roadway or public right-of-way within the boundaries of Rockford Township.
3. No construction materials, building materials, debris may be stored within any public roadway or public right-of-way within the boundaries of Rockford Township.
4. No items will be placed within the right-of-way, which will endanger the traveling public on township roads.
5. The term "stored" shall apply to any item, which is located within the public right-of-way or on township roads longer than a 24-hour period.
6. Any vehicle or item found stored in violation of this ordinance may be towed or otherwise removed and impounded at the direction of any officer of the Wright County Sheriff's Department or Minnesota State Highway Patrol and the owner thereof shall be responsible for payment of all towing, removal, and/or impounding fees.
7. Violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor, punishable in accordance with state law.
8. This ordinance becomes effective immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
