ORDINANCE NO. 200-1

**ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SERVING OF ALCOHOL
DURING USE OF TOWN HALL PROPERTY**

The Town Board for the Rockford Township, Wright County, Minnesota, hereby ordains as follows:


Section 1. Use of Alcohol in Town Hall. Alcohol may be served and consumed by persons or groups renting the Rockford Town Hall only under the following conditions:

- a. No fee or charge shall be imposed on guests for alcohol served during use of the Town Hall.
- b. No Township officers, employees or agents shall serve alcohol on the premises of the Town Hall.
- c. A Wright County Sheriff's Deputy must be present at all times during which alcohol is served or consumed. The expense of having said Deputy present shall be born by the person or group renting the Town Hall. At least 30 days prior to the date of the Town Hall rental, the person or group renting the Town Hall shall confirm with the Town Clerk that arrangements have been made to have a Wright County Sheriff's Deputy present during the event at which alcohol will be consumed. If no such arrangements are made with the Town Clerk by said date, the Town Clerk may contact the Sheriff's Office to arrange for the presence of a Sheriff's Deputy for said event, and shall bill all costs incurred by the Township arising from the presence of the Sheriff's Deputy to the person or group renting the Town Hall.
- d. Service of alcohol must cease by 12:01 a.m.
- e. Alcohol may not be served or consumed on the Town Hall grounds outside of the Town Hall building.
- f. Persons or groups serving alcohol while renting the Town Hall must first sign a 'Use Agreement' where, among other things, said persons or groups indemnify and hold the Township harmless for damage or loss incurred by said persons or groups or third parties during use of the Town Hall.


- g. A damage deposit in the amount of \$ _____ is posted with the Town Clerk prior to use of the Town Hall.
- h. For groups larger than ____ people, an insurance policy in the amount of \$ _____ is provided naming Rockford Township as an additional insured party.
- i. All laws and regulations regarding the service and consumption of alcohol are obeyed at all times while the Town Hall is in use.
- j. Upon application to the Town Board by any person or group renting the Town Hall and for good cause shown, the Town Board may modify or waive the applicability of one or more sections of this ordinance.

Passed by the Town Board of the Rockford Township this 14th day of December, 1999.

This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication in the official Township newspaper.
