

ORDINANCE NO. 97-1
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING
ON TOWNSHIP ROADS


The Town Board of Rockford Township does hereby ordain:

1. The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate parking on township roads and township right-of-way during the winter months in order to expedite the removal of snow and ice from the township roads.
2. No motor vehicle including passenger cars, buses, trucks, trailers, boats or other similar vehicles may be parked on any public roadway or public right-of-way within the boundaries of Rockford Township from November 1 to April 1 of each year.
3. Any vehicle found parked in violation of this ordinance may be towed and impounded at the direction of any officer of the Wright County Sheriff's Department or Minnesota State Highway Patrol officer and the owner thereof shall be responsible for payment of all towing and impounding fees.
4. Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor.
5. This ordinance becomes effective immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
