

RESOLUTION 2020-11.5

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CLERK OF Rockford TOWNSHIP TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN WRIGHT COUNTY AND Rockford TOWNSHIP FOR THE TRANSFER AND SPENDING OF CARES ACT FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) is a respiratory disease that was declared a global pandemic by the World Health Organization on March 11, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act was signed into law on March 27, 2020, and was in part available to qualifying local, state and federal agencies to cover expenses related to unbudgeted expenditures incurred between March 1 and December 30, 2020 due to the public health emergency caused by COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2020, Minnesota Governor Tim Walz formally allocated funding for counties, cities and townships in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, Rockford Township applied for and was awarded \$ 84,650.00, and formally accepted CARES Act funding on August 21, 2020, to directly apply to a broad range of necessary expenditures incurred as a result of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Rockford Township desires to transfer \$ 16,575.39 of CARES Act funding to Wright County to be spent in accordance with the terms of said agreement and the provisions of the CARES Act for allowable COVID-19 related expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rockford Township Board that Clerk McDougall, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the transfer and spending of CARES Act funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption on November 5, 2020.
