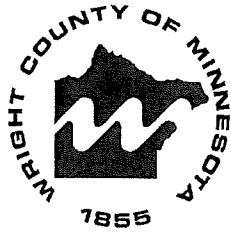

WHEREAS, Wright County Highway 147 was identified as a turn- back candidate,

WHEREAS, all of Wright County Highway 147 located in Rockford Township has been identified as a turn-back candidate,

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute § 163.11 Subd. 5A (2018) outlines the procedures that a County must follow in revoking a county highway to a township,

WHEREAS, the Wright County Board of Commissioners held a public hearing on September 1, 2020 in the Rockford Township Hall,

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing was served on the Rockford Township Supervisors by certified mail,

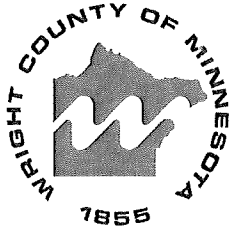
WHEREAS, the service was completed 30 days prior to the public hearing,

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing was also published in the official county newspaper,

WHEREAS, Wright County, after conducting the public hearing and opening the hearing to comment from the public, is going to revoke that portion of Wright County Highway 147 which is located in Rockford Township to Rockford Township,

WHEREAS, Wright County has entered into a separate agreement with Rockford Township concerning the repairs and maintenance of County Highway 147 and Rockford Township has agreed the condition of County Highway 147 is comparable to other County Highways located in Rockford Township in Wright County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Wright County Board of Commissioners that pursuant to Minnesota Statute § 163.11 Subd. 5a (2018) that portion of Wright County Highway 147 which is commonly identified as being County Road No. 147 (Division Street East), within the limits of the Rockford Township (south half of roadway only) - from the intersection of Calder Avenue SE to the east 380 feet, approximately 380 feet total length, all being in Rockford Township, County of Wright is hereby revoked to Rockford Township;
