The Rockford Town Board of Canvass Meeting was held at the Rockford Town Hall on March 12th, 2002, and was called to order at 9:37 p.m. The Board met to canvass and certify the Annual Election results. Present were Wetter, Beise, McDougall, Walker and Taylor.

The results were as follows: 2 – Supervisor positions for 3-year terms: Dennis Beise had 205 votes, no votes were 51, and misc. write in votes were 36, and 5 spoiled ballots. Dennis Beise was elected for 1-Supervisor position 3-year term.

Pam Kelley had 161 votes, Duane Rolstad had 48 votes, no votes were 79, and misc. write in votes were 4, and 5 spoiled ballots. Pam Kelley was elected for 1-Supervisor position 3-year term.

Ballot Option “D” question: 100 votes for yes, and 196 votes for no, 1 blank ballot. Ballot question did not pass.

Clerk/Treasurer (only valid if the ballot question passed)
Joanne Hanley had 162 votes, no votes were 124, and misc. write in votes were 6, and 5 spoiled ballots.

Total votes = 292
Absentee = $\frac{5}{297}$
