TOWNSHIP ELECTION The township election will be held on **Tuesday, March 14, 2017.** There will be an election for two supervisor positions this year; they are both three-year terms. You can file for office with our Clerk, Rachelle, during office hours or by appointment.

The filing period is open from Tuesday, January 3, 2017 until Tuesday, January 17, 2017. On January 17, the office will be open until 5 p.m. Normal office hours are Monday Wednesday & Friday 7 a.m. – 11 a.m. & Noon - 3:30 p.m. There is a \$2 filing fee.



VOTING INFORMATION The polling place for the township election is our Town Hall located at 3039 Dague Avenue S.E., Buffalo. The hours on Election Day are 7 a.m. - 8 p.m. **Absentee ballots** will be available through the Wright County Auditor's

GARBAGE & RECYCLING CONTAINERS - OTHER ITEMS

Please keep all items off the road. When plowing snow, the road crew will not go around any items left in the roadway. As a guide, keep any items such as garbage and recycling bins, in your driveway, behind an imaginary line corresponding with your mail box.



MAILBOXES will only be repaired or replaced if they are taken



down from a direct hit from the plow; only mailboxes that were legally installed and meet the state regulations for acceptable mailbox supports will be replaced. These standards are available from our office. Your additional tubes for

newspapers etc. should not hang below the minimum height requirement stated in the standards.

NO PARKING Regulated by township ordinance, there is no parking allowed on any township road at any time. (Township Ordinance #2010.3, a copy is available on our website.)



SNOW PLOWING State Law (M.S. 160.2715, a, 1) says it shall be unlawful to obstruct any highway or deposit snow or ice thereon. Please, do not plow snow onto or across a public road or leave snow piles on the road or in the right-of-way. This snow may cause a hazard. If accident or equipment damage were to occur, you may be liable. The township is sending letters to violators and the sheriff may be asked to issue a citation for repeat offenders.

The Fine is up to \$1,000 for Violations
