Township Pit Area Closed

Unfortunately, we have had problems with the brush, compost piles and other areas in our pit. People were leaving items not allowed, and not following the directions posted in the pit. The Town Board reluctantly had to close this area to the public. If you need a burning permit, please call our office, or you can also get them from the MN DNR website.



Grass on Township Roads

When you mow, please blow your grass toward your property, not onto the roads.

Grass deposited on the roads may cause a serious accident, which could cause you liability. In addition, it causes road maintenance problems. It costs you tax dollars for road crew time to move the grass clipping before they can do road maintenance. Mowing grass on or placing anything on town roads or right-of-ways is prohibited by township ordinance and State Law.

Covid-19 and Elections

To reduce congestion and long wait times that may occur at the two upcoming elections this year, we highly recommend that you consider absentee voting for both of the upcoming elections, if possible.
